- grass cutting of open spaces every 2 weeks from March to October
- tree, hedge and shrub maintenance
- ivy and street weed removal
- · environmental works
- leaf collection during winter season
- path edging
- inspection and maintenance of play equipment

You can report any issues to them.

Older people

<u>Search Newcastle</u> run a handyperson service for older people living in the West End of Newcastle. They can help with smalls repairs, home maintenance and gardening.

<u>GoodGym</u> volunteers help people over the age of 60 with gardening and small household tasks such as changing a light bulb, or putting togerher furniture. To ask for help with you need to be referred by a charity, community, church or social or health worker.
