

Newcastle Stop Smoking+ Service

The Newcastle Stop Smoking+ Service helps people living, working or registered with a GP in Newcastle to quit smoking. This is a 12-week programme to help and encourage you to stop smoking. They can provide free or cheap products to help manage your nicotine cravings, like patches and gum. They support adults and young people aged 11 and over who live or work in Newcastle. They will support you to reduce or stop smoking safely. They can send e-vouchers to your local pharmacy where you can collect products to help you stop smoking.

- local drop in sessions at community venues
