

Bereavement Services Office - Newcastle City Council

For deaths in Newcastle upon Tyne you must register the death at The Register Office. Ring to make an appointment.

Those who can register a death are:

- A relative.
- A person present at the death.
- The occupier of the premises where the death occurred if he/she knew about it.
- The person arranging the funeral (not the undertaker).
