

Crisis Skylight Newcastle

If you are homeless and need emergency housing advice, please contact [Newcastle City Council's Housing Advice Centre](#).

If you are homeless or at immediate risk of becoming homeless, you can access Crisis' services for free. They run an Engagement Gateway session at their centre, 12.30 to 3.30 pm Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

They also offer support with:

- **Education:** Develop skills, confidence and prepare for work. Activities include: IT, cooking, art, yoga, photography
- **Work:** Employment coaches help to get you ready work. Includes support to build your CV, experience mock interviews, find work placements, access to grants and take part in courses to access work.
- **Progression Coaches:** Listen to your hopes and needs, guide and motivate in 1:1 appointments
- **Housing:** Information, advice and support with all aspects of your housing needs. Includes a Renting Ready programme which helps build skills, knowledge and confidence to gain and maintain accommodation
- **Health and wellbeing:** Mental health counselling, one to one appointments and drop in sessions, group workshops with different topics such as confidence, stress and anxiety
- **Volunteering:** build your skills, confidence and experience. Volunteer at Crisis or elsewhere.
- **Homeless Health Peer Advocacy service** is free and confidential. #Healthnow with Groundswell. Supporting homeless people be more confident, to use health services. This includes GP registration, preparing and getting to health appointments and supporting you with any follow up.
