- To clear gas and electricity debts owed to other suppliers.
- For Bankruptcy deposits/Debt Relief Orders (DRO's), (these payments are known as FAPs (Further Assistance Payments)).
- purchase essential energy efficient white goods and cookers

The Trust also funds voluntary sector organisations to provide money and fuel debt services.
