Segedunum Roman Fort is an interactive museum on the most excavated fort along Hadrian's Wall.

It shows what life was like in Roman Britain using:

- Hadrian's Wall
- a Roman Gallery
- a 35 metre Viewing Tower which gives views across the site and wider area
- special exhibitions and events
- slow museum sessions for people with dementia

Admission charges apply, children under 16 go free.
