- moving around your house and transfers from or to bed/chair/toilet
- help to carry out everyday tasks independently
- household tasks to keep the home tidy, safe and clean
- help with getting out and about easily
- support to attend meetings, appointments, social activities
- shopping and errands
- collecting benefits or money
- dealing with correspondence
- companionship
