

Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit

What is Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit?

If you have a certain level of disability because of an accident at work or through work activity, you may be able to claim Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit. There are two types of Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit relating to:

- diseases (caused through work activity)
- accidents

You can't claim Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit if you were self-employed in work that caused your injury.

Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit – 'diseases'

You can claim Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit if you were employed in a job that caused your illness or disability. The scheme covers more than 70 diseases. For example:

- a disease caused by working with asbestos
- asthma
- chronic bronchitis or emphysema
- deafness
- pneumoconiosis (including silicosis and asbestosis)
- osteoarthritis of the knee in coal miners
- prescribed disease A11 (previously known as vibration white finger)
- and many more

Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit – accidents

You may be able to claim Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit if you are disabled because of an accident or event that happened at work.
