How can I find my nearest public toilet?

[The Great British Public Toilet Map](#) is a website where you can search for public toilets in the area you are visiting. You can search by postcode, map view or use your current location.

This includes finding those for radar keys, accessible to wheel chairs, baby changing and gender neutral. They may be located in shops and cafes. Type in the area you are visiting, then look at the map and click a pin for all the details you need. You can help by adding or editing toilets that you know about to their website.

There are 39 public toilets listed in Newcastle upon Tyne in 2024

Changing Place toilets

[Changing Places](#) help to find the nearest accessible toilets to you in the UK. The toilets are designed for children and adults who may be limited in their mobility. Equipment is available to help you to get on and off the toilet, or to change your continence pad. This includes things like a hoist, a height-adjustable changing bench and a shower. These toilets have more space so your carer or carers can help you if needed. There is a changing area with screens or curtains to give you some privacy.

[Search the Changing Places map by town or postcode](#) to find toilets near you, their opening times and how access them. To help you plan ahead before you visit a new place, check the opening times of the building. Members of the public can only access the toilets when the buildings are open. [One Strawberry Lane](#) is a working space in the City Centre. The building has an accessible adult changing facility available to anyone who needs it. It includes an accessible shower with hoist and a toilet with emergency pull cord. To use the accessible changing area speak to the host at the entrance of the building when you arrive. The building is open to the public Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm.

[Newcastle Civic Centre](#) and [Northern Stage](#) have accessible toilets designed by [Muscular Dystrophy UK](#) that include a hoist and other specialist equipment. The toilets are open to the public when the buildings are open.

Radar Key – National Key Scheme

The Radar National Key Scheme (NKS) offers disabled people independent access to over 9,000 locked public toilets around the country with one key. Toilets fitted with National Key Scheme (NKS) locks can now be found in shopping centres, pubs, cafes, department stores, bus and train stations and many other locations in the country. Use the [Great British Public Toilet Map](#) to find their location.
