

Allerdale House

Allerdale House is an Assisted Living community for people over the age of 55 who have care and housing needs, in Chapel House. There are 32 one and two-bedroom apartments. This housing is near local shops, GP surgeries, pharmacies, a church and bus routes.

This is affordable, rented accommodation designed to meet the needs of people with care needs. Specially trained staff are on hand 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, providing a range of specialist care support during the day. Giving you peace of mind that help is at hand overnight in an emergency. Facilities and support available at Allerdale House includes:

- communal lounges for social events
- mobility scooter storage
- café
- communal garden
- secure camera entry system and independent front door
- Housing Plus support officer on site

- housing repairs and maintenance costs are covered
- furniture rental available
- optional daily wellbeing calls
