Children North East are a local charity supporting families, children and young people. They offer a wide range of services including:

- Supporting parents' relationships with their babies
- Baby and toddler groups
- Intensive support for families in crisis
- Peer mentoring for young people
- Counselling for children and young people aged 9-25
- Poverty Proofing© work in schools, healthcare, early years and cultural settings
- Sexual health and relationships drop in sessions
- Support for neurodivergent young people, who have recently received or are waiting for a diagnosis, including Masquer-Aid programme
- <u>FAB Group</u> for young people aged 11 to 25 with Special Educational Needs. The group meets every month in Newcastle to make friends and share experiences

They also offer training for professionals, youth groups, HAF provisions, community activities and more. Visit their website for more information.
