The Children's speech and language team at Newcastle upon Tyne NHS Foundation Trust has an open referral system, so that a parent, school, GP can refer into the service. They aim to minimise any negative impact of speech, language or communication difficulties for the child and their family, as well as on their education and social lives. Their services include:

- acquired speech and language difficulties (e.g. head injury, stroke)
- Autism
- early language development, including understanding and use of spoken language
- preschool social communication difficulties
- developmental language disorder
- Pronunciation difficulties
- Moderate learning difficulties
- hearing impairment
- stammering
- swallowing
- voice
- young people with an educational health care plan
