- Diabetes in renal patients.

They provide specialist education for patients with diabetes:

- DESMOND
- Dose adjustment for normal eating (DAFNE)
- Insulin pump education
- Diabetes sensors and other technology and various education
- Retinal screening for diabetes patients.
