Their regular weekly activities include:

- **Tuesday Hub** 1pm 5pm: a drop-in afternoon where you can have a hot drink, chat, take part in activities such as board games and quizzes (some weeks), or simply bring something to do of your own. Free wifi is available. Children are welcome with parents or carers.
- The Beacon: a drop-in coffee morning on 10am 12pm
- Adult art group on Wednesdays 10am 12pm
- Craft group 10am 12pm, 2nd & 4th Thursdays of the month.

They also run one-off social events and children's activities.
