

Foodcycle

FoodCycle work with supermarkets, small independent grocery shops and markets to source perfectly edible surplus food in a safe and responsible way. They run weekly community dining and community services related to food and wellbeing.

Community meals – volunteers collect surplus food and cook it to make a nutritious 3 course community meal. Everyone is welcome, meals are free, no referral or a voucher

GrowCycle – A weekly get together to dig, weed, nurture and grow some vegetables for their community meals

Check in and Chat – arrange a 20-minute call each week for a social chat with a volunteer. Free, available to anyone in the UK and you can sign-up whether or not you come to one of their community meals.
