

Oaktrees Newcastle

Oaktrees Newcastle is a 12 step intensive programme for people who want to become sober. This is a community rehabilitation service for people in Newcastle with drug, alcohol or substance misuse issues. The programme is focused on abstinence. It is an alternative to residential rehabilitation.

You attend the programme for 12 weeks, and take part in a structured timetable of groups and workshops from 9am to 4pm, Monday to Friday. You are given support by staff and peers as you learn how to live in recovery from addiction.
