They provide 1 to 1 personal employment support in community venues across the city. They also provide support via online video calls, telephone and other digital platforms. Newcastle Futures help to:

- create a CV and cover letter
- identify your transferable skills
- find vacancies (jobs, apprenticeships, volunteering, work experience),
- write job applications to impress employers
- prepare for and succeed in job interviews
- explore funding to access training
- build your LinkedIn profile and use it for job searches
- progress your career and upskill
- access support from specialist agencies
