

Independence at Home

Independence at Home (IaH) is a charity that provides grants to people of all ages who have a physical disability, learning disability or long term illness who are in financial need. Grants must be applied for by professional referrers such as:

- Health, social care or advice services
- Citizens Advice workers
- Voluntary or charity workers who provide a health, social care, welfare or advice service
- Professional workers from Tenancy Support, Care and Repair organisations and Housing Associations.

To apply they will need written evidence of your medical condition and a quote on a company letterhead for the item or repair works needed.

Independence at Home's grants are between £300 and £600 and depend on the item of equipment purchased or building work carried out. They provide grants for:

- Mobility and Travel Equipment
- Special Disability Equipment
- Home Adaptations
- Communications Equipment
- House Repairs
- Kitchen Equipment
- Beds and Bedding
- General Furnishings
- Removal expenses
