They also organise and facilitate social and cultural events that promote cross-cultural integration. Many of their programmes bring people together through shared activities such as befriending, sport and gardening. They advocate for refugees and new communities, providing services and information that help people engage in life in the UK. They also help service providers adapt their services to the needs of these communities.
