North East Drive mobility help people maintain or regain independence as drivers and passengers following a change in health.

North East Drive mobility provide:

- driving assessments to drivers or provisional licence holders from the age of 16 and over in receipt of Personal Independence Payment (PIP)).
- off-road assessments at their Newcastle Centre for those without a licence.
- powered wheelchair and mobility scooter assessments
- child car seating assessments
- specialist driving tuition for those who have previously been assessed at the Centre.
- guidance for people looking for alternatives to driving, in partnership with the Mobility Hubs Advice Service
