

## Tell Us Once

Tell Us Once is a service that lets you report a death to most government organisations in one go.

Many services can be notified, and these include:

- the local council
- HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC)
- Department for Work and Pensions (DWP)
- Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA)
- Passport Office

### How to use the Tell Us Once service

First you should [register the death with the registrar](#).

The registrar will provide you with a unique Tell Us Once reference number. This reference number allows you to [access the Tell Us Once service at GOV.UK](#)
