Such as a hoist, a height-adjustable changing bench and a shower. These toilets have more space so your carer or carers can help you if needed. There is a changing area with screens or curtains to give you some privacy. <u>Visit the Changing Places website</u> to see the opening times and how access them. You can only access the toilets when the buildings are open. You may need a Radar Key to open the toilet.
