

Hauxley Wildlife Discovery Centre

Hauxley Wildlife Discovery Centre is a [Northumberland Wildlife Trust](#) nature reserve (internationally recognised for bird wildlife) with an eco-friendly [Wildlife Discovery Centre](#), walking trails and views across Druridge Bay.

Facilities include:

- 6 hides, including 1 'members only hide', which give you a great opportunity to quietly observe a host of birds, including grey herons, tree sparrows, turnstones and shelducks. A wildlife sightings board can be updated if you spot a bird
- a circular walk with 1 fully accessible trail to 2 hides,
- regular activities for children and adults that can be booked on our web site.
- play area
- Lookout cafe
- Accessible toilet and Baby changing facilities
- free Wifi

Entry is free but there is a charge for parking.
