Northumberlandia is a public art installation and [Northumberland Wildlife Trust](#) country park featuring a unique land sculpture of a female figure, set in 46 acres of landscaped parkland. Northumberlandia offers walking, wildlife watching, markets and community events.

Facilities include:

- 4 miles of footpaths around the land sculpture and woodland.
- accessible toilets (open during café hours)
- parking and electric car charging point
- free Wifi
- regular activities for adults and children
- Dog Friendly: Dogs on leads are welcome throughout the site and inside the café.
- Accessible ramp access to the café and visitor centre.
