Weetslade Country Park is a [Northumberland Wildlife Trust](#) 94 acre nature reserve. A former colliery site, it has a range of natural habitats including wildflower meadows, grassland, scrub, reed bed and woodland. It offers panoramic views of the North Sea, Cheviots, and Newcastle.

Facilities include

- Walking & Cycling Trails – part of the Sustrans Reivers Coast to Coast route
- Parking
- Dog Friendly: Dogs on leads are welcome throughout the site
- accessible main tracks for wheelchair users and pushchairs
- picnic areas
