

Changing Places

Changing Places is a website where you can find the nearest accessible toilets to you in the UK. The toilets are designed for children and adults who may be limited in their mobility. Equipment is available to help you to get on and off the toilet, or to change your continence pad. This includes things like a hoist, a height-adjustable changing bench and a shower. These toilets have more space so your carer or carers can help you if needed. There is a changing area with screens or curtains to give you some privacy.

Search the Changing Places map by town or postcode to find toilets near you, their opening times and how access them. To help you plan ahead before you visit a new place, check the opening times of the building. Members of the public can only access the toilets when the buildings are open. You may need a Radar Key to open the toilet.
