Do you know somebody who is carrying out criminal activity, but fear the consequences of being identified as the person who reported them? You can report concerns anonymously to Crimestoppers using their online form or freephone telephone number. You can give information 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

On the Crimestoppers website you can

- help locate the UK's most wanted individuals sought in connection for crimes including murder, sexual assault, burglary, violence and more
- search the most recent appeals via post code, crime type or operation
- help keep the UK and your community safe
