

Coniston House

Coniston House is a sheltered housing community for people over the age of 60, in Slatyford. There are 22 apartments and 12 Tyneside flats with one or two bedrooms. This housing is near local shops, GP surgeries and bus routes.

This is affordable, rented accommodation with housing and wellbeing support services. Facilities and support available at Coniston House includes:

- communal lounge for social events
- laundry room
- communal garden
- secure camera entry system and independent front door
- Housing Plus support officer on site

- housing repairs and maintenance costs are covered
- furniture rental available
- optional daily wellbeing calls
