

Bamburgh House

Bamburgh House is a sheltered housing community for people over the age of 55, in Westerhope. There are 31 one and two bedroom apartments. This housing is near bus routes, local shops and a supermarket, GP surgeries, pharmacies, church and a post office.

This is affordable, rented accommodation with housing and wellbeing support services. Facilities and support available at the Bamburgh House includes:

- communal lounge for social events
- laundry room
- communal garden
- secure camera entry system and independent front door
- onsite car parking
- scooter store
- Housing Plus support officer on site

- housing repairs and maintenance costs are covered
- furniture rental available
- optional daily wellbeing calls
