

Conewood House

Conewood House is a sheltered housing community for people over the age of 55, in Fawdon. There are 22 one and two bedroom apartments. This housing is near local shops, supermarket, GP surgeries, pharmacy, dentist, community centre, library, bus and metro routes.

This is affordable, rented accommodation with housing and wellbeing support services. Facilities and support available at Conewood House includes:

- communal lounge for social events
- laundry room
- communal garden
- scooter store
- secure camera entry system and independent front door
- Housing Plus support officer on site

- housing repairs and maintenance costs are covered
- furniture rental available
- optional daily wellbeing calls
