Since 2005, Seeing Ear has been supporting visually impaired people across the UK, by providing books in an accessible electronic/alternative format at no cost to the user. The Library is accessed via the internet and each book can be read as an adaptable Word document, Braille (both Grade 1 and Grade 2) and DAISY 3 audio files. These can be accessed on computers, tablets or special audio players, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

There are currently more than 9,000 books on the Library, and genres include best sellers, thrillers, history, cookery, gardening and many more.
