This local site is a mosaic of different habitats like woodland, freshwater ponds, and grasslands supporting an array of invertebrates. It is also a popular spot for watching dragonflies like Banded Demoiselle, Common Hawker and the Four-Spotted Chaser.

Please wear suitable clothing and a hat as it might be sunny or warm. If you have them, it may help to bring a pair of binoculars for an enhanced dragonfly -watching experience.
