Northumberland Wildlife Trust look after over 60 nature reserves in Newcastle, North Tyneside and Northumberland. They protect wildlife and promote nature conservation. They also create homes for wildlife and maintain natural spaces to visit and enjoy throughout the year. This includes:

- [Hauxley Wildlife Discovery Centre](#) a nature reserve (internationally recognised for bird wildlife) with an eco-friendly [Wildlife Discovery Centre](#), walking trails and views across Druridge Bay.
- [Northumberlandia](#) a public art installation and country park featuring a unique land sculpture of a female figure, set in 46 acres of landscaped parkland. Northumberlandia offers walking, wildlife watching, markets and community events.
- [Weetslade Country Park](#) a former colliery site and nature reserve. It has a range of natural habitats including wildflower meadows, grassland, scrub, reed bed and woodland. It offers panoramic views of the North Sea, Cheviots, and Newcastle.
