The Welford Centre is for adults over the age of 18 who have learning disabilities and additional complex needs.

The building is fully equipped with a range of resources including:

- · communication aids
- physiotherapy equipment
- · specialist moving and handling equipment
- rebound therapy room
- sensory room
- pottery room
- · meeting rooms
- adult changing rooms with overhead hoists
- large dining room
- shower rooms with specialist shower trays
- kitchens for cookery
- art and craft room

To access this service you will need a referral from the Adult Social CarePoint team.

This is a designated <u>Safe Reporting Centre</u> where people can report <u>hate crime</u> or hate incidents without having to contact the Police directly.
