- Face to face and online counselling and mental health services
- National C-card scheme (free condoms)
- Groupwork – Calm Minds, DV, Anger, Personal Wellbeing, Misogyny, Exam Stress, Healthy Relationships etc.
- Youth Work: including Social Action Projects and Volunteering Opportunities.
- Young Volunteers

Streetwise operates several Early Help Youth Hubs, in various School and Community Settings across Newcastle.
